

## ADMINISTRATION POLICY #20

## SCHEDULE "A" - RUSSELL CEMETERY

## Rules and Regulations regarding Memorial Stones

- The owner of any plot must adhere to Administration Policy #20, #21 & #22.
- Overall height of such a Memorial or Memorial Stone (together with the base and the foundation on which it sits) shall in no case be more than fourteen inches (14") above ground level.
- The height of the stone or the Memorial itself shall in no case be more than eight inches (8") above the base on which it sits.
- That the base upon which such stone or Memorial sits shall in no case be of a height of more than six inches (6") above the foundation upon which it sits.
- Every such stone, together with its base and foundation, shall be installed either by the caretaker of the Russell Cemetery or other Municipal Staff working under his/her supervision.
- In no case will a cement frame work or any other type of framework or covering be allowed on top of or around any grave.
- No perennials, shrubs or trees will be permitted to be planted on a plot.
